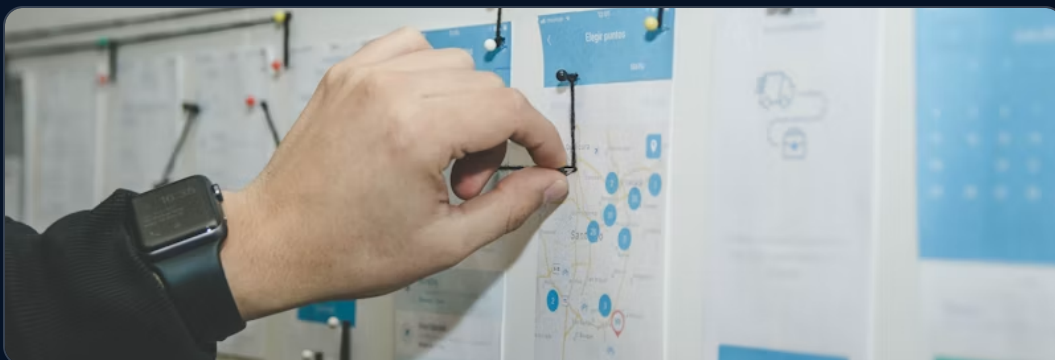

Starting a software project is an important investment. Proper planning helps reduce risks, control costs, and ensure the final product meets your business goals.

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Step 1 – Define Your Business Goals

Before discussing technology or programming languages, clearly identify what you want to achieve from a business perspective. Software should directly support business growth.

- > Third-party API Integrations
- > Automated Background Workflows





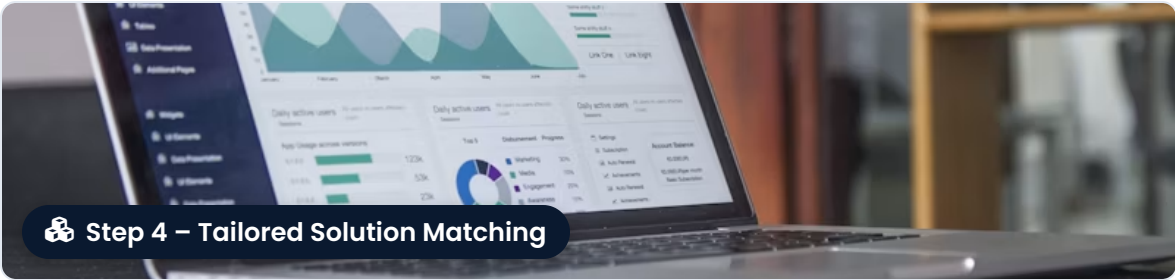
Feature Prioritization Matrix (Must-Have vs. Nice-to-Have)

Use this evaluation matrix to score potential features based on business value versus development effort:

Authentication	Email/Password Login + Password Reset (MVP)	SSO Integration + Multi-Factor Auth (Phase 2)
User Interface	Responsive Web UI with Tailwind CSS (MVP)	Native iOS & Android Mobile Apps (Phase 2)
Intelligence	Rule-based email alerts & reporting (MVP)	Local LLM (Ollama) & AI Predictive Scoring (Phase 2)
Integrations	Single Payment Gateway (Stripe/Razorpay) (MVP)	Multi-ERP & Accounting API Synchronization (Phase 2)

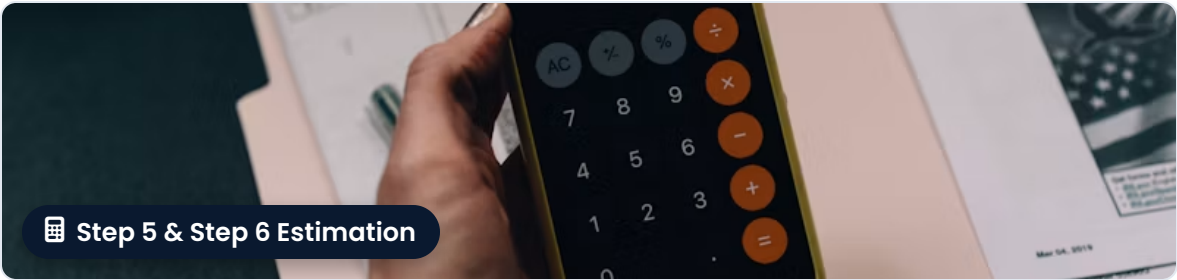

Common Mistakes to Avoid

Starting Without Clear Requirements

Changing Major Features Mid-Development

Adding large new modules midway causes schedule delays and inflates development budgets.

Choosing Technology Based Only on Price

Selecting cheap, outdated tools creates technical debt and expensive rewrite costs later.

Underestimating Security & Testing

Skipping security audits or rushing quality assurance risks data breaches and post-launch bugs.

Not Planning for Maintenance

Software requires ongoing server updates, security patches, and backups after production launch.
